HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT REPORT:

Highway Commissioner Czernek reported that he attended a meeting at DuPage County regarding speed bumps. From what he learned at the meeting speed bumps are considered a liability and not favored by the fire departments, paramedics and County. An option discussed for additional speed control is "shoulder striping" that makes lanes look more narrow. But the cost of doing this is approximately \$2.00 per foot.

Electronics recycling for the month of July seemed close to the usual average of 40,000 pounds, but he did not have an official weight of what was collected as of this meeting. Highway Commissioner Czernek said the Highway Department will need to re-evaluate if they can continue to do electronic recycling next year, but hopes to continue at least until winter.

Highway Commissioner Czernek has accepted an invitation from the Village of Roselle to partner in their September 17, 2016 recycling event to be held near the train station. It will include paint, paper, batteries, glasses, etc.

It was noted that they finished paving the parking lot behind the Supervisor's office and General Assistance. There will be some changes to parking spots to make some van-accessible handicap spots.

Highway Commissioner Czernek and Bob Nogan will attend the Highway Commissioner Summer Seminar of TOI in September.

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Highway Commissioner Czernek then introduced Officer Pierscionowski to the Board and complimented him on his efforts to date. Bob has gotten nothing but positive feedback from the residents regarding Officer Pierscionowski.

OFFICER PIERSCIONOWSKI:

Officer Pierscionowski gave the board the history of his background and reported on what things were happening in the Township.

He reported that he has been working on the speeding issue on Garden Avenue that was reported by a concerned citizen at a board meeting a few months ago. Officer Pierscionowski has had a speed trailer put out and is checking into other things that can be done. So far, it seems things have gotten better. He will continue to keep a close eye on things as school will be starting soon.

He reported that his patrol hours are 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Trustee Tolentino inquired about the differences in his position with that of Officer Urso who visited us in June. Officer Pierscionowski explained the different positions.
