- **Grant Presentations:**

- **#18- INCA Relief Center-** By Sara M. Provides Mental Health First Aid in a culturally important way and provides transitional housing. Currently has a 10-bed facility to help women that are struggling with independence. Looking for \$59, 875 for PT Therapist, supervisor, and educational materials.
- **# 11 Easter Seals-** By Theresa. Pediatric Developmental disability. They help provide early intervention and identify delays before kindergarten. Looking for \$ 80,000 for therapy and rehabilitation for toddlers and infants.

- **#12 Easter Seals-** By Theresa. Infants, Toddlers, Children with developmental disabilities. Looking for \$40,000 to support families and children.
- **#13 Fellowship Housing Corporation-** By Betsy Canady. Helping single moms that are facing homelessness or are homeless. Help women develop housing, life skills, increase savings, and decrease debt. Women work with case managers to develop skills to be on their own within 2 years. Looking for \$22,000 to help with transitional housing and wrap around service program.
- **#14- Glenbard Early Childhood Collaborative-** By Jeanine- Helps address mental health and individualized care provide home visits for prenatal to age 3. Looking for \$75,700 for cost of 2 PT home visitor salary.
- **#15 Good Works Results LLC-** By Daniel Riemenschneider- Helps midlevel leaders to build up the capacity for others. Looking for \$25,500 for 8 ½ day forums to help network, discovery sessions, and collaborate with others, and materials.
- **#16 Haymarket Center-** Substance use Treatment Center in Chicago that offers detox, inpatient, Recovery Home, and IOP/OP. Looking for \$ 68,625.90 to with medical care, recovery, Outpatient services.
- **#17 Hopeful Beginnings –** By Natalie Rodriguez. Offers Perinatal care Mood Disorder for men and women. Clients are offered services for up to 12 months that focuses on Depression, anxiety, grief and loss that is all associated with Pregnancy loss. Looking for \$ 40,000 for PT clinician and PT community outreach educational professional.
- **#19 Little City Foundation-** By Paul- Houses within the community that offer people with intellectual developmental disabilities to develop life skills and work on daily life functions. Looking for \$ 6,120 to help fund wellness activities for clients.
